2 Mentorship Program

Each semester, NCU invites alumni and corporate professionals to serve as mentors. Through one-on-one sessions, students receive guidance on career planning, learn about company culture, gain real-world experience, and develop practical skills for future jobs.

Eligibility |

All NCU students are welcome to apply, no matter your year or department. If there are too many applicants, priority will go to graduate students and third- or fourth-year undergraduates.

Program Content |

- Career interest exploration
- Self-assessment and goal setting
- Industry insights and company visits
- Résumé and cover letter review
- Mock interviews and job search tips
- Project-based learning
- Networking meals with mentors and peers

One-on-One Industry Mentor Consultation

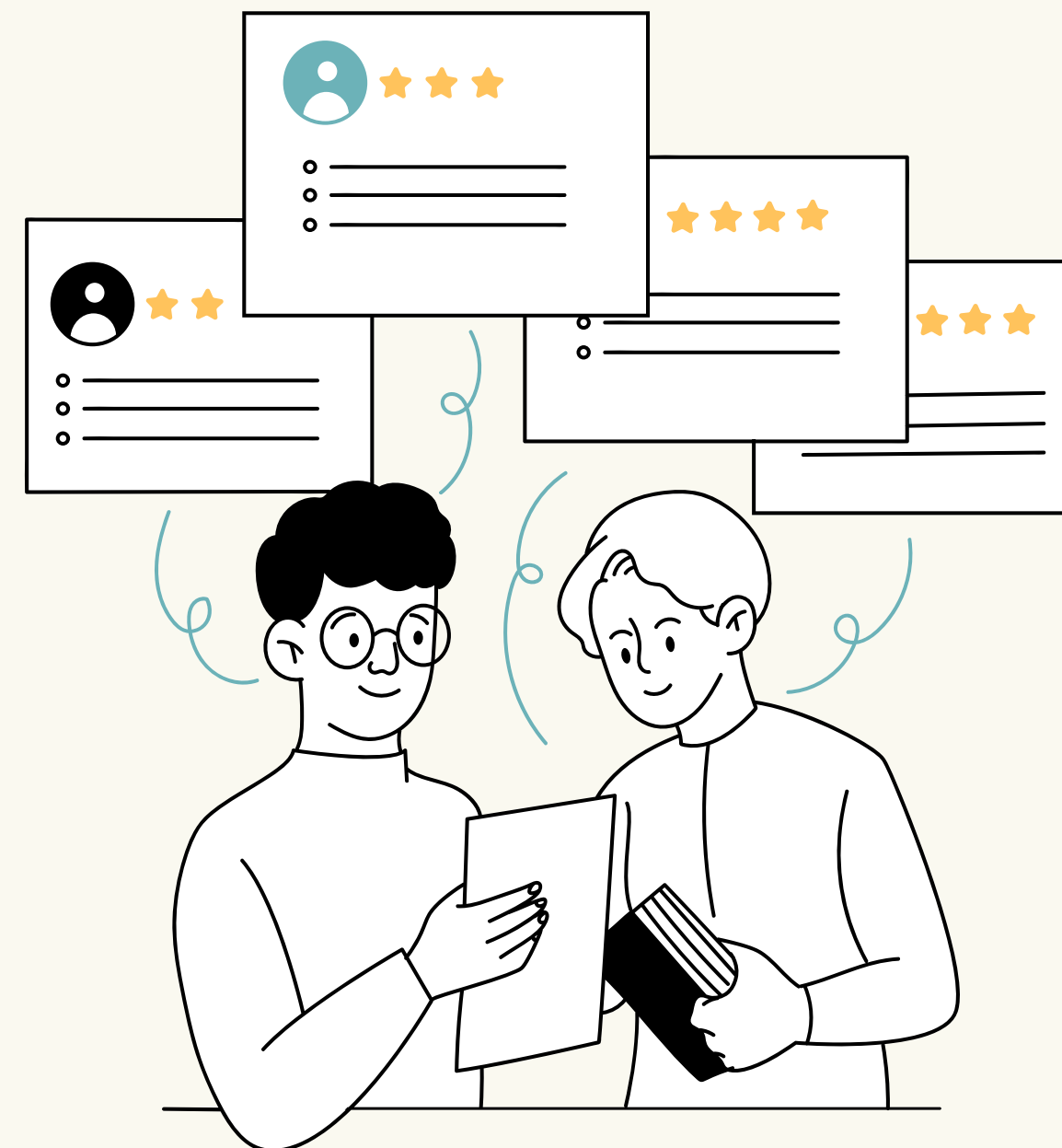
Professionals, certified consultants, and alumni provide one-on-one consultations, offered monthly during the semester, to help students explore workplace culture and build career skills.

CPAS Career Assessment & 1-on-1 Counseling

Discover your strengths and career interests with the CPAS Career Aptitude Test, a personality-based tool to help identify suitable career paths.

International students can also receive guidance on job hunting in Taiwan, CV reviews, interview preparation, and adapting to local workplace culture.

Each session is one-on-one with a professional counselor, lasts 1 hour, and is offered monthly during the semester.

- Define their personal career goals

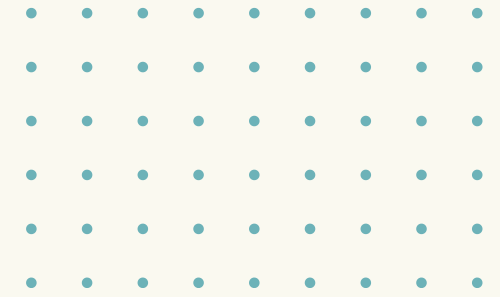
Company Site Visits serve as a vital bridge between academic learning and professional development, helping students transition smoothly into the workforce.

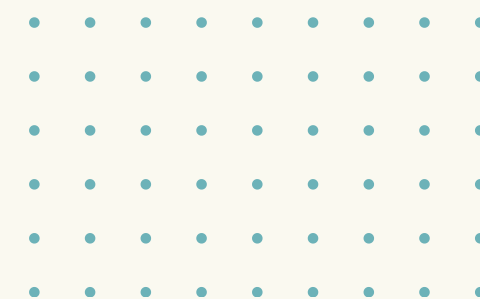

Training Highlights |

- Over NT\$200,000 worth of training sessions focused on soft skills. Software classes include Adobe Creative Suite and Microsoft Office Suite. Practical workshops feature portrait photography, video production taught by industry directors, public speaking, résumé writing, and interview skills. Additional online courses tailored to team needs include layout design, video effects, and presentation design.
- Hands-on guidance from the Career Center's campus talent recruitment coordinator—training in project management, software operation, visual aesthetics, communication, business etiquette, marketing proposals, and crisis management.

Team Benefits |

- Completion certificate awarded for excellent performance and training participation—a valuable asset recognized by alumni in both local and international job interviews.
- Service learning hours are credited upon full participation in training and event duties.
- 1–3 off-campus team-building retreats per cohort.
- Meals are provided during team meetings, planning sessions, and events; one celebratory banquet is included.
- Priority access to company visit opportunities.

1 Company Info Sessions

Held twice a year, these events include the Spring Campus Talent Recruitment Sessions (March–May) and the Autumn Campus Talent Recruitment Sessions (September–October).

Dozens of leading companies are invited to host sessions tailored to students' needs. Company representatives come directly to campus to present industry insights, hiring criteria, and future workforce needs. These sessions provide students with a valuable opportunity to interact with professionals, understand job openings, and get a firsthand look at real-world expectations.

For companies, it's also a chance to build brand awareness and attract top talent. Students often gain early interview opportunities and valuable career advice directly through these sessions.

Career Fair

The Career Fair is the highlight of the Spring recruitment season (March-May), where over 100 companies are invited to campus to set up recruitment booths. This large-scale event serves as a platform for students to explore job opportunities, learn about industry trends, and even participate in on-site interviews with hiring managers.

Students not only gain direct access to company representatives and current job openings but also stay informed on the latest workplace developments—all without leaving campus. For many, the Career Fair is the gateway to landing their first job offer.

Tailored Campus Recruitment Events

Customized Company Info Sessions

Companies can apply to host customized presentations based on their internal hiring schedules. These sessions allow companies to interact with students personally, clearly communicate job openings, company culture, and talent needs. Time is also set aside for Q&A and networking to improve the match between students and employers.



Special Recruitment Events

Through creative formats such as mobile experience trucks, coffee trucks, on-the-spot interviews, and interactive games, these events create engaging spaces for company-student interaction. Companies can effectively convey recruitment needs while students enjoy an approachable and dynamic job-seeking experience.

Off-Campus Internship Program

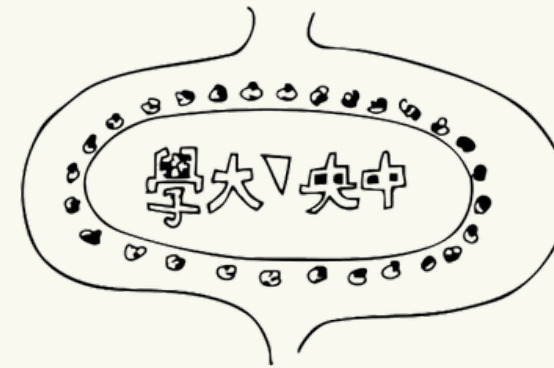
The Career Center coordinates the university-wide Off-Campus Internship Program, setting clear policies and partner institution standards to protect student rights and ensure a valuable internship experience.

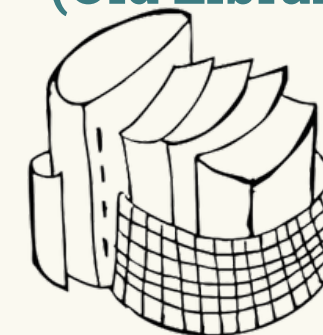
